



Cleaning and Maintenance

 The installed floor should be maintained temperature of 13°C and 30°C throughout its service life.

Prevention

- Always protect floors when moving heavy objects to prevent permanent scratches and tears.
- Use appropriate wide floor protectors under tables, chairs, and any heavy furnishing to avoidpermanent damage.
- Place walk off mats at all entrances, it helps protect the floor from water, grease, sand and dust
- During peak sunlight hours, the use of blinds or curtains is recommended.
 Prolonged direct sunlight can result in discoloration and volatile temperature variations causing damage to thefloor.
- Do not allow solvent to the seams, this may cause damage or become moldy.

Routine Maintenance

- Routine cleaning is important to prevent particles from abrading the surface of resilient floors.
- Clean the floor surface regularly.
- General cleaning can be carried out by sweeping, vacuuming, wet wiping.
 For heavy soiling usea polyurethane cleaner.
- Use a dry cloth or vacuum cleaner for cleaning. When water or any cleaning liquid is used, pleasesqueeze out all water before cleansing.
- All stain-forming and aggressive substances must be immediately removed from the surface
- Periodically wax the floor surface to keep it always better.
