

Residential Limited Lifetime Warranty

Casabella Quartz will warrant from the original date of installation Casabella Quartz material that fails due to a manufacturing defect when fabricated and installed by a Casabella Quartz Authorized Fabricator/Installer. This warranty only applies to the repair or replacement of material that has been permanently installed in the purchaser's residence. The option to repair or replace is at the sole discretion of Casabella Quartz.

Introduction

The Residential warranty is only available to the original owner of a single-family residence in which the Casabella Quartz material was originally installed. In the case of a newly constructed single-family residence, this warranty is only available to the "first" owner purchasing the residence and is transferable according to the procedure outlined below.

Warranty Terms & Conditions

This warranty applies to material installed after 07/1/2022.

- This warranty applies only to Casabella Quartz and does not apply to any other products.
- This warranty only applies to Casabella Quartz materials that have been permanently installed in the "interior" of a single-family residence and has not been moved from its original place of installation.
- This warranty applies only to a residence where the owner is the occupant.
- This warranty applies only to materials and/or services that have been paid in full.
- This warranty only applies to materials that have been maintained according to Casabella Quartz Use and Care Instructions.
- After installation you must register your warranty at www.casabellaquartz.com/warranty within thirty (30) days of installation. If no record of your warranty is on file, you must provide proof of purchase. Proof of Purchase consists of a copy of your original receipt or invoice showing the name of the Owner, Dealer or Fabricator. Casabella Quartz will honor your warranty upon presentation of proof of purchase even though no warranty registration is on file.

- You must cooperate with Casabella Quartz or its authorized agents in our efforts to perform our obligations under this warranty.
- **WARRANTY TRANSFER:** This warranty is transferable under the following conditions: The original or first owner must have initially registered the warranty with Casabella Quartz as specified above. The original or first owner must submit in writing the name, address, and phone number of the new owner. The new owner shall receive a prorated 10-year limited warranty, which is prorated from the original date of installation. Under no circumstances shall the transferred warranty exceed ten (10) years from the date of original installation.
- If your Casabella Quartz material fails due to a manufacturing defect, Casabella Quartz will, at its sole discretion repair or replace such materials. Casabella Quartz will seek to attain the best possible result, whether the material is repaired or replaced. However, exact color match is not guaranteed.
- No representative, dealer, salesperson, distributor, fabricator, or any other person is authorized to make warranty decisions or promises on behalf of Casabella Quartz with respect to its products.

Warranty Exclusions

- This warranty is for residential installation only as defined within this warranty. Products used for commercial purposes are covered by our Commercial Limited Warranty. Commercial use includes but is not limited to, rental properties, stores, offices, or any other places of business.
- All exterior installations.
- The use of Casabella Quartz as flooring material.
- Improper use or abuse, this includes but is not limited to, mishandling of product, excessive heat, uneven exposure to weather conditions, physical or chemical abuse or improper care and maintenance.
- Impact damage
- Scratches — Casabella Quartz are scratch resistant but not scratch proof. Proper care must be exercised including the use of a cutting board as part of your routine care.
- Routine Maintenance, this includes but is not limited to, removing of surface stains or water spots. Follow the directions in the Casabella Quartz Use & Care guide for routine maintenance. Residential Limited Lifetime Warranty Casabella Quartz will warrant from the original date of installation Casabella Quartz material that fails due to a manufacturing defect when fabricated and installed by a Casabella Quartz Authorized Fabricator/Installer. This warranty only applies to the repair or replacement of material that has been permanently installed in the purchaser's residence. The option to repair or replace is at the sole discretion of Casabella Quartz.
- Fabrication that is not performed according to pre-scribed fabrication and installation procedures as outlined by Casabella Quartz Quartz Surfaces. Improper fabrication and/or installation is the sole responsibility of the fabricator and/or installer.
- Visible defects visible at the time of fabrication and that were not avoided during fabrication. Fabricators are required to perform a visual inspection of all material prior to fabrication and again prior to installation.

- Seam appearance or performance, adhesives, caulks, or other accessory items. Once installed the primary causes of seam separation or cracking are shifting or movement of the substrate, cabinets or foundation and thermal shock. Thermal shock can occur when a hot pan, dish or other hot object is left on the countertop for more than a brief time. Trivets or hot pads should always be used. These issues are not material defects and are subject to proper use and care by owner.
- Chemical damage
- Creative material use such as bending or curving.
- Material that has been reduced in thickness.
- Sink installations.
- Mechanical fasteners affixed directly into the material.
- Inadequate support for the installation
- Damage caused by overhangs beyond the recommendations for overhangs provided by Casabella Quartz.
- Damage caused by dry cutting or dry polishing.
- Damage caused by failure to follow the recommended minimums for edge details thereby resulting in increased exposure to chipping.
- Mitered edges or corners where the miter has not been properly cut according to the recommendations provided by Casabella Quartz.
- Any alteration of the factory applied finish.
- Any additional modifications such as plumbing, electrical, tile, cabinets, flooring etc. that may be necessary to repair or replace the Casabella Quartz product covered under this warranty.
- Natural variations in color, size, shape or distribution of the pattern or the background of the Casabella Quartz product. These characteristics are inherent and unique characteristics of the product. Color samples provided to consumers are only representative and not an exact replication of what will be installed in your home.

Casabella Quartz is not responsible for damage or injury caused in whole or in part by Acts of God, job site conditions, architectural/engineering design, structural movement, vandalism, or accidents.

Casabella Quartz shall not be responsible in either contract or tort for any loss of direct, indirect, consequential, incidental, special, exemplary, or punitive damages arising out of the use or the inability to use the products covered by this warranty. Some states do not allow exclusion or limitation of incidental damages, so the above limitations or exclusions may not apply to you.

CASABELLA QUARTZ EXPRESSLY DISCLAIMS ALL WARRANTIES NOT STATED HEREIN, INCLUDING TO THE EXTENT PERMITTED BY APPLICABLE LAW, ANY WARRANTY THAT MAY EXIST UNDER NATIONAL, STATE, PROVINCIAL OR LOCAL LAW, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO ANY IMPLIED WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY OR FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE. SOME STATES OR OTHER JURISDICTIONS DO NOT ALLOW THE EXCLUSION OF IMPLIED WARRANTIES, SO THE ABOVE LIMITATION MAY NOT APPLY TO YOU.

Care and Maintenance

Daily Care and Maintenance

Use a mild dish soap, such as Dawn® Ultra Original Liquid Dish Soap or Windex® Multi-Surface Cleaner. You may also use a 50/50 mix of vinegar and water.

After cleaning, be sure to rinse your surface with warm water and dry with clean, cotton cloths or paper towels.

Stubborn, Dried-On Stains and Spills

Use a light or non-abrasive cleanser by applying it to a clean cotton cloth or paper towel, not directly onto the surface. Use a circular motion on the affected area, rinse and dry thoroughly.

The following cleansers are recommended for use on Casabella Quartz surfaces with dried-on spills.

- Soft-Scrub® Gel with Bleach
- Bar Keepers Friend® Cleanser powder or creme
- Simple Green® Extreme Clean
- Simple Green® Lemon Fresh
- Windex® Multi-Surface Cleaner
- Windex® Multi-Surface Cleaner with Vinegar

When using Bar Keepers Friend Cleanser powder, first apply it to a damp clean cloth or paper towel, then squeezing together several times to form a paste before applying to your surface.

To remove any adhered material such as food, gum or nail polish, start by scraping away the excess material with a plastic putty knife. Clean any remaining residue with a damp cloth.

Chemicals and Harsh Cleaners

Avoid exposing your surface to any of the following:

- Oven, grill, toilet bowl, furniture, or drain cleaners
- Paint and floor strippers, or tarnish removers
- Oil-based soaps and cleansers
- Battery acid or any other caustic substances

Immediately rinse the area with water if your surface is exposed to these types of products. Prolonged exposure may cause discoloration or damage to your surface.

Resistance to Heat

Casabella Quartz is heat resistant, but not heat proof. We strongly recommend using trivets or hot plates to protect your surface from damage caused by sudden temperature changes — especially when using cooking units such as electric frying pans or crock pots. Never place your hot cookware directly onto your surface.

Cutting

Never cut directly onto your surface, as it will result in residual metal knife marks. These are not scratches and can be removed by using the same steps for treating Stubborn Stains and Spills. We strongly recommend the use of cutting boards.

No Sealer Required

Do not apply sealers or polishes to your Casabella Quartz surface. They are not necessary and over time can make your surface appear dull and/or inconsistent.
